Survey of Likely General Election Voters **Georgia Statewide**

January 29 – February 1, 2026 | n=600 | $\pm 4.00\%$

Insights & Analysis

- There is still much room for improvement regarding trust in the administration of elections: voters believe the administration of elections in Georgia is getting **either less trustworthy** (33%) or **staying the same** (32%). Just 22% believe it is getting more trustworthy.
 - **Republicans largely fall in line** with the topline numbers: 36% say less trustworthy, 28% staying the same, and 23% more trustworthy.
 - **Voters 55+** (28% more trustworthy) and **Black voters** (28% more trustworthy) stand out as believing the administration of Georgia elections is getting **more trustworthy**. **Non-college women** stand out in the other direction (40% less trustworthy).
- Voters show **much less trust for the administration of elections in the United States** as a whole – 57% say less trustworthy, 20% about the same, and 17% more.
 - Republican voters have **more trust nationally** (29% more trustworthy) **than in Georgia**, but **46% say less trustworthy** and 25% about the same.
- Overall, voters show **little trust from the top down** for institutional images to do the right thing with **heavy uncertainty for lesser-known officials**, and **defined figures polarizing opinions**.
 - There is a **staunch level of distrust for Trump** (-14 trust) **with much more trust for Kemp** (+14 trust). **Kemp garners more trust the Trump across the board**, especially among voters 55+ and non-college voters.
 - **Brad Raffensperger also enjoys net positive trust** (+5 overall). He is strongest with D's (+17 trust) and I's (+7 trust), but moderately underwater with R's (-6 trust).
 - Over half are “**unsure**” on **Gabriel Sterling, Chris Carr, and Burt Jones**.
 - The **people who administer elections and count ballots** (+12 trust) are much more trusted than the **Georgia State Election Board** (-6 trust), which is largely trusted by just Democrats.

Insights & Analysis

- Trust in **Georgia's election administration shows improvement from 2020 to 2024** as only 17% believe the 2024 election had widespread fraud or process errors that altered results (down from 37% for 2020), and **2026 is right in the middle** – 26% anticipate widespread fraud or process errors.
 - Among Republican voters, **the positive progression is even more drastic** – 66% say there was widespread fraud in 2020, 16% in 2024, and 26% anticipate it in 2026.
 - **Non-college voters** show the **greatest level of concern over fraud** year-over-year.
 - Republicans, Democrats, and Independents each share **similar feelings about widespread fraud in 2024** (~16%), and all share at least **+5% increased expectation** of results-altering errors or fraud in **2026 compared to 2024**.
- Compared to other states, a slim plurality of voters believe Georgia does **about the same job** (40%) **ensuring ballots are accurately cast and counted**. 13% more believe **Georgia does a better job** (32%) **than a worse job** (19%).
 - Republican voters are modestly more likely to believe the **state does a worse job** (26%) than other states with **34% saying about the same** and 29% better.
- Regardless of any misgivings voters have about elections and their administration, **73% are likely to accept the results** of **national elections** and **77% for the U.S. Senate race**.
 - Republican voters are **slightly more likely to accept the U.S. Senate race results as well as high-profile elections** compared to all voters.
 - Democrats are 5% more likely to accept results from the U.S. Senate race in Georgia compared to high-profile elections in other states.

Insights & Analysis

- Voters are **largely divided in their opinions about mail-in voting** as 50% believe it opens the door for fraud vs. 41% who believe it is convenient and secure.
 - **Opinions are split along partisan lines** as 84% of Republicans believe it is fraud-prone compared to 79% of Democrats who think it is convenient and secure.
 - **Independents are split evenly** among both opinions. Information frames such as paper ballots/audits, photo ID, and drop-box controls consistently move voters to being more confident.
- Voters' biggest concerns about the 2026 election results are **election officials not following laws or procedures for counting ballots** (79% concerned), **cyber attacks affecting results** (77% concerned), **non-citizens voting** (75% concerned), and **court decisions changing election rules to close the election** (74% concerned).
 - Some threats arouse partisan splits, but Republican voters are aligned with the overall electorate on the degree of concern about most threat options.
- Looking at the three **biggest threats** to the election results in 2026 overall, they are (in order) **election officials not following laws or procedures** (43%), **non-citizens voting** (42%; driven by Republicans), and **cyber attacks** (41%).
 - **Court decisions changing rules** close to the election came in narrowly behind (37%) as a threat **Republicans and Democrats are both worried about**.
 - **Deployment of federal troops** (37%) is the top concern for Democrats (61%).
- There is strong agreement among overall voters (73%) and Republican voters (65%) that **states should set and run their own elections** with federal agencies having limited oversight.

Insights & Analysis

- A **plurality** believe **SB 202 reforms made elections more secure** (37%) with 21% saying less secure and 24% makes no difference.
 - Reforms are **largely seen in a positive light** as Republicans stand at +30 more secure, Independents at +11, and Democrats +4 more secure (31% no difference).
 - 85% say their **in-person voting experience was either excellent** (52%) or **good** (33%), and this opinion is held across partisan and ideological splits.
- **Replacing machines** with hand-marked ballots **draws more opposition** (49%) **than support** (26%). Republican voters are moderately supportive (38 support, 28 oppose) while Democrats provide the strongest opposition.
- Initially **70% of voters overall are confident** that Georgia's voting and ballot tabulation process will accurately cast and count votes in 2026. Confidence is consistent across partisan splits as 67% of Republican voters and 77% of Democrats are confident.
- After messaging, **confidence jumps 5 points to 75%** overall and **+11 net among Republican voters** to 72%.
 - Groups that show some of the most increased confidence after messaging include **men 55+ (+14 net), Republicans (+11), White voters (+12) high propensity voters (+9), and those who believe there was fraud in 2020 (+18) and 2024 (+18)**.
 - The most effective message overall is **Election Accuracy**. This message works best with Republicans, Independents, men under 55, in Metro ATL, swing voters, and those initially unsure.
 - **Transparency** is less effective overall but works well with Democrats, women, and in the Surrounding ATL area.
 - **Photo ID** is also less effective overall but works best with non-college men and in Southeast GA.


Insights & Analysis

- The **Fulton County raid polarizes and depresses confidence among Democrat-leaning blocs** while **boosting it among Republican-leaning blocs**.
 - **Pluralities call the FBI search very inappropriate** (40%) vs. 30% **very appropriate**, driven across partisan splits.
 - Net effect on confidence splits: **44% say it makes them less confident** (27% much less) while **33% say more confident** (16% much more) - with *much* less concentrated among Harris/Democrats, urban, college-educated voters and *much* more among Trump/Republican, rural voters.
 - **Independents and swing voters** stand at roughly **+21 less confident**.
- The **generic 2026 ballot environment is highly polarized and competitive**. The generic congressional ballot stands at **D+4** (48 D, 44 R).
 - The **generic ballot for governor stands at D+2** with swing voters and Independents showing more support for a Republican governor than a Republican member of Congress.
 - The **generic ballot for secretary of state is tied 44 – 44**.
 - **Gabriel Sterling trails a generic Democrat 40 – 43**. He runs 4 points behind a generic Republican, due women 55+, high propensity voters, and Republicans moving to undecided.
- **U.S. Senate: Jon Ossoff edges the unnamed Republican** (47 – 45), with clear partisan/racial/geo splits (Ossoff is stronger in Metro ATL, Black voters, college-educated voters, while the Republican is stronger in rural, White voters, non-college voters).
- The **Republican primary ballots are highly undecided** without a clear candidate separating themselves from the pack.

Insights & Analysis

- Segmentation analysis identified three voter groups:
 - **Dem Base/Lean Election Confident** (15%) show **slight confidence** in election administration (49%) that gets a little bump after messaging (54%) and are less confident after the Fulton raid. They skew heavily female, under 55, moderate/liberal, most Black, least-educated, and are the lowest propensity voters.
 - **GOP Base/Lean Election Confident** (46%) show **confidence** in election administration (62%) that gets a bump after messaging (69%) and are more confident after the Fulton raid. They skew male, 55+, most conservative, most White, most rural/small town, and are the highest propensity voters.
 - **Dem Base/Election Confident** (40%) show the **most confidence** in election administration (88%) and after messaging (90%) and are the least confident after the Fulton raid. They skew female, under 55, most liberal, majority Black, most-educated, and are higher-propensity voters.





How do you plan to vote in the November 2026 general election for U.S. Congress, Governor, and state offices?



Would you say the administration of elections in Georgia is getting more trustworthy, less trustworthy, or staying the same?




Generic Congressional Ballot


















How much do you trust or distrust The Georgia State Election Board to do the right thing?

How much do you trust or distrust the people who administer elections and count ballots in Georgia to do the right thing?








Partisanship by Response



How do you plan to vote in the May 2026 Republican primary election for U.S. Congress, Governor, and state offices – if at all?







If the Republican primary election for Lieutenant Governor was held today, and you had to make a choice, who would you vote for?






U.S. Senate GOP Primary

If the Republican primary election for U.S. Senate was held today, and you had to make a choice, who would you vote for?








Percent Change: 2020 to 2026 Election Confidence




State Election Result Acceptance














Biggest Threat Concern





Transparency: *Georgia elections use paper ballots and conducts public audits after each election. Anyone can watch these steps, so voters know the process is transparent.*

Photo ID: *Photo ID is required to vote in person, and absentee ballots must include a driver's license or state ID number. Election officials verify eligibility to ensure only qualified voters cast ballots.*


Identity Verification: *Mail ballots include a signed envelope and ID information. Counties verify voter details to prevent fraud while keeping voting accessible.*

Election Accuracy: *Georgia processes early ballots as they arrive, with results released only after polls close. Election Day ballots are checked and counted to ensure every vote is accurate.*

Drop Box Security: *Ballot drop boxes are located inside early voting sites, monitored during voting hours, and follow chain-of-custody procedures. Every transfer is tracked, making them a secure way to return ballots.*

Citizenship Verification: *Georgia verifies citizenship when people register to vote. Election officials regularly conduct audits to ensure that all registered voters are US citizens.*

How to Read a Cygnal Message Map

Effectiveness (X Axis)


The horizontal position of each message indicates the message's *persuasion power* – the **most important** function. Messages positioned **furthest to the right** are the **most effective in changing** a voter's opinion. Pay attention to the **effectiveness scale** at the **bottom** and how messages compare graph-to-graph; standard range is 0 to 2.

Net Impact (Y Axis)


The vertical position of each message indicates the NET impact – or *popularity* – of each message. Messages with **highest position** have the **broadest appeal**. The closer a message is to the **bottom** of Net Impact, the more **drag** it has meaning it can cut against you.

Believability (Bubble Size)


The size of each message bubble reflects the **intensity** of responses (called *believability*). Larger bubbles reflect a high concentration of respondents choosing *much* more/less likely. This is a **comparative tool** for impact but third in importance of the overall graph.










